"Elective" rotations can consist of any of the "Specialty" rotations (listed next page) or of clinical research or quality improvement projects. Those residents electing to do research or clinical quality improvement projects during elective time spend 100 percent of their time in research with the exception of maintenance of outpatient continuity clinics. With rare exceptions for special circumstances, elective rotations occur at Site 1 (St. Rita's Medical Center).
